NOTICE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

All dogs six (6) months and older must have an individual ASCA registration, LEP number or an ASCA QTracker number to compete in ASCA sanctioned Obedience/Rally Trials. A dog will be allowed to be shown at the trial where the handler applies for an ASCA tracking number. No dog without an ASCA individual registration, LEP number or ASCA QTracker number may compete in any ASCA Obedience/Rally Trial. Photo copies or originals of registration or tracking number papers must be presented to the Registration Table upon request when entering ASCA sanctioned Obedience/Rally Trials. Each non-ASCA registered dog will be required to have an ASCA Tracking Number. There is a one-time fee of \$10/ dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA member (minimum membership type of Service is required). ASCA membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. If your dog does NOT have a tracking number, you can get the form by following this link. <https://www.asca.org/wp-content/uploads/2016/04/trackapp.pdf>. Then include that form and check or Money Order payable to ASCA with your entry. Forms will also be available at the trial. **Bitches in heat will not be allowed to compete.**

Trial hours are 7:00am until 7:00pm

The ring will be located on the north most **grass lawn**. We recommend that you bring sun and wind protection.

No day of show set ups are allowed on the show lawn until 8:00 a.m. Saturday in order to allow for the show committee to set up for the show. Roping off or "pre-reserving" of day set up spots will not be allowed prior to 8:00am on Saturday.

NorCal will be hosting Conformation shows on the same lawn, so ***please do not set up too close to the conformation ring(s).***

DIRECTIONS TO DIXON MAY FAIRGROUNDS: 665 South First St, Dixon, CA

From Sacramento: Take I-80 west towards Dixon. Exit at Hwy 113 south towards Dixon. Stay straight as the road curves left over I-80, following the signs to stay on Hwy 113-S. Hwy 113 becomes First Street. Follow First St for a couple of miles, passing through downtown Dixon. The fairgrounds are three blocks past downtown on your left.

From Bay Area: Take Hwy I-80 east towards Sacramento. Exit at the Dixon Avenue/A Street and go right on A Street. Turn right on First Street. The fairgrounds are three blocks south on your left.

FOR ALL: Once you see the fairgrounds, go past the office and main entrance drive and turn left into the south end of the fairgrounds.

OVERNIGHT RV & TENT CAMPERS

All overnight parking of ASCA only exhibitors (those not competing in the TRACS Agility Trial) will be handled by NorCal ASC and must be reserved and paid for in advance. We cannot guarantee RV parking spots will be available if not reserved by May 21, 2018. Please read this entire section for important information.

RV and/or paid camping sites (with electricity) will be located at the northern end of the “North Lawn” across from the NorCal & WASOC show/trial lawn.

Please mail your request for RV / camping to Gina/Teresa Stubblefield – 3388 Shadelands Court, Concord, CA 94519.

The cost of RVs and/or camping are as follows and **all fees must be paid in full prior to release of your arm band numbers.**

- RVs (includes hook ups) - \$35 per night
- Camping (includes electricity outlet) - \$25 per night
- Camping (with NO electricity outlet use) – Free**

The fairgrounds will charge any camper \$25 for use of the electrical hook ups. So if you intend to use electrical hook ups (even for a short time), please submit your \$25 per night. **This is a fairground rule for which WASOC/NOR CAL ASC has no control and can provide no exceptions.

The school lawn area is limited to tent campers unless otherwise instructed by NorCal. There will be no RV set ups or camping allowed on the NorCal / WASOC show/trial lawn without prior consent of NorCal ASC.

Please drive slowly when entering the fairgrounds so as not to interfere with the agility trial. There will be a large number of RV and campers expected at the fairgrounds over the show weekend as there is an agility trail on the grounds as well.

We ask that everyone please be courteous to the agility club members and their exhibitors when coming in with RV's, etc. Thank you!!



ASCA® Service Membership and Tracking Number Application

Beginning 1/1/2003 for non-ASCA® registered dogs – In order to have ASCA® qualifying legs tracked and to receive ASCA® titling certificates, each non-ASCA® registered dog will be required to have an ASCA® Tracking Number. This is a one-time fee of \$10/dog. At the time of applying for the tracking number, the individual owner must also be an ASCA® member (minimum membership type of "Service" is required). ASCA® membership does not need to be maintained in subsequent years. **It will be the responsibility of the owner to identify to ASCA® the show(s) and leg(s) earned when applying for a Tracking Number for those ASCA® qualifying legs earned from 1/1/2003 until submission of application.**

➤ FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ◀

Do I have to have a tracking number to compete?

No, you do not need a tracking number in order to compete in Agility or Stock.

You will need a tracking number to enter an Obedience trial or Tracking Test.

Your dog does not have to be a purebred to receive a tracking number from ASCA.

Why would I need or want a tracking number for my dog?

If you would like to have your dog's points and titles recorded by ASCA®, and if you'd like to receive title certificates in the mail for your accomplishments, you might want to obtain a tracking number.

How much is the total cost for a tracking number?

In order to obtain a tracking number for your dog, you must be at least a "Service" member. The cost for Service Membership is **\$10**.

Your membership is good for one year; however, it does not need to be maintained in subsequent years, unless you want to obtain another tracking number for another dog after your membership has expired.

This membership fee is **in addition** to the tracking fee of **\$10** per dog. A tracking number is good for the lifetime of the dog. If you only have one dog, the total cost would be **\$20**. For two dogs, the cost would be **\$30**, for three, the cost would be **\$40**, etc.
